



With an Avian Influenza Prevention Zone (AIPZ) in place across England and further housing measures imposed in parts of the Midlands, poultry producers remain on high alert.

At Toft Farm Growers, a mixed family business near Stafford, led by Mark Holt, tight biosecurity is the first line of defence in protecting their substantial turkey flock.

However, they also recognise the importance of being prepared for the worst – having a clear action plan in place should an outbreak occur.

## The breakdown

### Comprehensive biosecurity protocols

Formerly a dairy farming business, the Holt family diversified into poultry in 2019 to complement their 260ha arable enterprise. Four modern shed units were built, now housing approximately 40,000 turkeys in total that supply Avara Foods.

Freddie Webb, Toft Farm Growers' poultry shed manager, explains they work closely with Avara and biosecurity experts Livetec Systems to maintain maximum protection for both their birds and business income.

"Birds arrive from the hatchery at a day old, with stags grown on until 140 days, while the hens are thinned out, being a new site, we're luckily set up to be as biosecure as possible." The measures implemented at Toft Farm to minimise the risk of disease transmission include 'shower on' facilities, shed-specific clothing, and step-over barriers.

Mr Webb adds: "One handy thing we've installed more recently is a pressure washer permanently rigged up on the yard, so we can easily spray disinfectant all over the yard or onto any incoming vehicles – there's no skimping on disinfection."

As part of assurance schemes with Avara, Red Tractor, Marks & Spencer and Tesco, annual biosecurity audits are completed across the site.

"On top of that, we have the support of our Avara area manager who makes recommendations on how we can uphold tight biosecurity measures," says Mr Webb.

Despite these measures, he acknowledges the risk of AI remains, particularly from third-party visitors such as contractors and catching teams.

This risk became clear when another farm in their supplier group contracted AI.

"After talking to the farm who had contracted AI, they mentioned how difficult it was to have everything organised when dealing with APHA (Animal and Plant Health Agency)," says Mr Webb.

"From organising muck removal, cleaning and disinfection, to liaising with APHA to provide the information they needed about the farm that might not necessarily be right to hand – it sounded very stressful."This prompted Mr Webb and his team to take additional preparatory steps. "Should the worst happen, we wanted to be well prepared with an outbreak management plan in place," he says.



## The solution

#### What services did Freddie use?

With support from Livetec, the Toft Farm team developed an Emergency Response Plan (ERP) to ensure they could act immediately if AI struck.

Julian Sparrey, technical director at Livetec, explains they work side-by-side with poultry managers to create a bespoke action plans, including essential documentation, such as premises maps and key contact lists. "When speed is critical in an emergency, being forewarned is forearmed," says Mr Sparrey.

"This plan is incredibly valuable for helping farm businesses reduce the time between suspecting disease and starting the recovery process, helping them return to normal operations as fast as possible."He highlights the financial benefits of being prepared.

"For instance, contingency planning support from Livetec enabled BFREPA chairman and Scottish egg producer, James Baxter, to save over £45,000 by acting quickly when he was impacted by AI in 2023," says Mr Sparrey.

These savings were thanks to speed - crucial for both hen welfare and ensuring the best possible valuation of the surviving hens, which directly impacts compensation. "By streamlining the paperwork process with the APHA vet, who was then able to assess the live hens more quickly, Mr Baxter maximised the compensation he received," Mr Sparrey says.

Having key documents readily available can make all the difference in such situations. Producers are provided with two copies of the ERP, one to follow and another to hand over to officials.
